Stuart Eisentrager, Street Superintendent requested Council permission to pursue the possibility of a share purchase with the City of Toledo for a pot hole patching machine that will cost around \$40,000.00. The Council is open to the idea and will make a final approval when they have a bid.

Ed Hardon asked that the Council consider selling the property where the Sugar Shack is located. The Council did not favor for or against the idea.

The Mayor and Council discussed the open council seat with the resignation of Doug Ray upon taking the Mayor position. The Council is going to publish a notice of intent to fill vacancy. They would like a written request from any parties that would like to be considered for the position. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.
