The regular meeting for the Tama City Council met Monday August 5, 2019 at 6:00 PM in the Tama City Council Chambers. Mayor Pro-Tem Tyynismaa called the meeting to order with the following council member answering to roll call: McAdoo, Haughey, Ray, Tyynismaa, Babinat. Visitors: Mike Haughey, Nick Peshel, Jason Bina, Shane Patterson, Elmer Baier.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Ray to approve the consent agenda which consisted of, Minutes of the last regular meeting on 7/15/19, bills paid 7/16/19 thru 8/4/19, bills to be paid 8/5/19 including Brown Supply for \$8,339.50, K & W Coatings \$44,700.00, Twin Cities \$115,080.33, and Dunn Concrete & Stone \$5,965.50. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Tyynismaa, seconded by Haughey to approve Resolution No. 10-19 a resolution closing 3rd St to vehicular traffic on August 24, 2019 from noon to 4:00 PM for an event. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

Elmer Baier presented his concerns about the UTV Ordinance No. 593 to the Council. The Council heard his concerns and are considering a one-year trial period for the new ordinance. It was moved by Haughey, seconded by Babinat to approve the second reading of Ordinance No. 593. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Tyynismaa to place Ordinance No. 594, an ordinance concerning rates for the water services increasing the rate by \$2.00 on file. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Haughey to waive the three separate readings for Ordinance No. 594. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by Tyynismaa to adopt Ordinance No. 594 as read on file. Roll call vote ayes: Babinat, McAdoo, Haughey, Ray, Tyynismaa. Motion carried.

It was moved by Tyynismaa, seconded by Ray to approve Resolution No. 11-19 a resolution setting the public hearing to amend series 2017 GO Bond issuance for August 19, 2019. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by Haughey to approve Resolution No. 12-19 a resolution authorizing notice of the right of redemption. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Tynismaa, seconded by Haughey to approve Resolution No. 13-19 a resolution setting the mileage reimbursement rate to follow the annual IRS rate. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

The Council discussed issues with trees on the berm. The Council would like to see that we add removal of tree stumps if a tree is removed. The City Attorney will look at revising the current Ordinance.

It was moved by McAdoo, seconded by Haughey to approve the bid for a new pump from Iowa Pump Works in the amount of \$16,266.70 plus freight. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by Babinat to approve the Waste Water Schooling agreement. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by McAdoo to approve Pat Campbell's bid for cleaning at a rate for \$410.00 bi-weekly. The City Clerk will prepare a contract to be bid annually. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Babinat seconded by Ray to approve the purchase of a Bobcat skid loader and attachments in the amount of \$36,820.24. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Tynismaa, seconded by Babinat to approve the purchase of a whirlpool air conditioner from Ternus Electric in the amount of \$1,296.00. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Ray to approve Resolution No. 14-19 which is a Proclamation for Power- Up Iowa. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by McAdoo, seconded by Babinat to adjourn. 7:44 PM
