

April 1, 2019

The regular meeting for the Tama City Council met Monday April 1, 2019 at 6:00 PM in the Tama City Council Chambers. Mayor Carnahan called the meeting to order with the following council member answering to roll call: Ray, Haughey, Tyynismaa, Babinat. Visitors: John Lloyd, Sierra Berger, and Justin Jacobi.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by Babinat to approve the consent agenda which consists of minutes from the last meeting on 3/18/19, bills paid 3/16/19 thru 3/31/19, and bills to be paid 4/1/19. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Haughey to approve Sierra Berger as the assistant Deputy Clerk at a salary of \$33,000.00. Sierra will be eligible for a raise in July with the rest of the city employees. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by Tyynismaa to approve Aaron Yuska's resignation as Building Inspector for the City of Tama. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Tyynismaa, seconded by Babinat to approve payment to Independent Insurance in the amount of \$96,624.00 for the City's insurance coverage. The over all total has decreases by \$16,624.00. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Haughey to approve Larry Thomas to fill a vacant position on the Board of Adjustments. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

The Council discussed the options for the sign at the Civic Center. After much discussion the Council directed the City Clerk to get an example of how it would look with the sign to only have "The City of Tama" at the top without a logo or design.

A motion was made by Tyynismaa, and seconded by Haughey to change the auditorium rental fee from \$75.00 to \$125.00 and to change the \$10.00 that we currently put into the maintenance fund up to \$50.00. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Haughey, seconded by Tyynismaa to lift the burn ban until May 6, 2019 with the exception of April 21, 2019. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

The Council has set dates for City Wide Clean up to be April 22-26<sup>th</sup>. This will be for yard waste only.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Tyynismaa to approve a donation of \$250.00 for Project Prom. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

Reports: Babinat- Has scheduled a time in June to meet with the Library Board in regards to their winter hours.

Ray- Would like to discuss the possibility of raising the price of parking tickets.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by Babinat to adjourn. 7:00 PM
