A work session for the Tama City Council met Monday October 1, 2018 at 5:08 in the Tama City Council Chambers. Mayor Carnahan called the meeting to order with the following council member answering to roll call: McAdoo, Haughey, Ray. Absent: Tyynismaa and Babinat. Visitors: John Lloyd and Jason Bina.

The Council discussed the 11 houses that letters were sent to. They directed Chief Bina and John Lloyd to work on nuisance abatements at 5 of the properties. Council also discussed the possibility of forming a group to help with clean up for citizens who are unable to do the clean up themselves.

It was moved by McAdoo, seconded by Haughey to adjourn. 5:54 PM.

The regular meeting of the Tama City Council met Monday October 1, 2018 at 6:00 PM in the Tama City Council Chambers. Mayor Carnahan called the meeting to order with the following council members answering roll call: McAdoo, Haughey, Ray, Babinat. Absent: Tyynismaa. Visitors: John Lloyd, Anne Michael, Colleen Davis, Duane Backen, Charlie Betz, and Jason Bina.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by Babinat to approve the consent agenda which consisted of minutes from the last meeting on 9/17/18, bills paid 9/18/18 thru 9/27/18 and bills to be paid 10/1/18. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

Tyynismaa joined the meeting at 8:03 PM.

This being the time and place, Mayor Carnahan opened the public hearing for the Code of Ordinances of the City of Tama, IA. There being no oral or written comments the Mayor closed the public hearing. It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Ray to place the new Code of Ordinance book on file. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Tyynismaa to approve the contract with Shuck Britson Engineering for the Lincoln Highway Bridge Project. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

Colleen Davis approached the Council about the memorial flag pole that they would like to put up at the Lincoln Highway Bridge Park. The Association is to check with Stuart or John for placement. The City will provide the cement and pea gravel.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by McAdoo to approve Tyler Ayala-Pagan to be hired as a certified police officer at a salary of \$43,500.00. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by McAdoo, seconded by Haughey to approve Donovan Horne and Cody Rodriguez to join the Ambulance Department. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

Duane Backen- Ambulance Director updated the Council on purchasing a new ambulance. They will be getting a lifeline rig totaling \$213,024.00 along with another powerlift for \$28,000.00 which leaves it below the budgeted amount.

The Council continued discussion on the issues with the windows at the Library. They directed the City Clerk to check into engineers in order to get specifications and work on the bidding process.

It was moved by Babinat, seconded by Tyynismaa to approve payment to Region 6 Planning Commission in the amount of \$4,950.00 for CDBG Housing services. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Ray, seconded by Haughey to approve payment to The Cahoy Group to pull out Pump #3 in the amount of \$2,778.00. Roll call vote all ayes. Motion carried.

Reports: Ray- Brought up concerns with the recycling area. Trash is beginning to pile up.

Babinat- Has been reviewing the 28E agreement with Tama County Economic Development and plans to get on the agenda to meet with them at an upcoming meeting.

Mayor Carnahan- Would like to thank the Street Department for helping in finishing the painting in the auditorium. Reminded everyone of the Planning meeting Wednesday October 3 at 5:30 for the Haunted Hayrack ride.

It was moved by McAdoo seconded by Tyynismaa to adjourn 7:23 PM.
