

November 26, 2018

A joint meeting of the City of Tama and the City of Toledo was held November 26, 2018 at 6:00 PM in the Toledo Council Chambers. The purpose of the joint meeting was to receive the annual update of the STC Rec Board, South Tama Rec Trail Committee, and the Tama Toledo Pool Board. The Councils also reviewed the possibility of South Tama Schools hiring a School Resource Officer.

Toledo Mayor Lloyd opened the meeting with roll call for Toledo. Mayor Carnahan called roll call for the City of Tama. McAdoo, Babinat, and Tynismaa. Absent: Haughey and Ray. Numerous visitors present.

Jerimi Kopsa, representative for the STC Rec Board, updated the Councils on the 2018 season. The Rec. Board served around 500 kids and were able to keep registration fees at \$25.00. They brought in \$40,797.79 in revenue and \$42,267.92 in expenses leaving their balance at \$13,002.29.

Jake Jacobson, representative for the Rec Trail Committee, presented information to the Councils. The Trail had \$2,902.99 in expenses, leaving their working balance at \$17,029.43. Jake asked the Councils to consider budgeting for future expenses for trail mix. Jake thanked the staff from both cities for their continued upkeep on the trail.

Shayna Zmolek, representative for the Tama-Toledo Aquatic Center reviewed the 2018 season with the Councils. Total Revenues were \$207,790.45 and expenses were \$192,553.49. There will be a change in pricing for family passes for the 2019 season. Shayna thanked the City of Toledo for their continued maintenance. The City of Tama will take over the financials for the 2019 season.

Dr. Jared Smith, STC Superintendent presented the Council's with information on the possibility of hiring a School Resource Officer. The Officer would be hired by the Tama Police Department with the school funding 75% of the salary. Dr. Smith along with Chief Bina have done a lot of research thus far and are still in the process of getting approval from the School Board and City Council.

It was moved by McAdoo, seconded by Pansegrau to adjourn 6:08 PM.
